ENQUIRY



This half term, we will explore the question 'Where will my travels take me?'

We will begin the Enquiry by becoming immersed in a special History Partake adventure (theatre company) experience who will take us on an imaginary experience through the oceans to find the hidden pirate treasure!

We will then learn about the Capital City of London and which landmarks we would find there. We will know that Big Ben, The Shard, London Eye and The Underground are all famous London landmarks.

After this, we will learn about the South Pole and how a famous explorer, Sir Edmund Hillary famously explored this space.

We will then travel to Twycross Zoo to see animals that originate from across the world. We shall focus on Chinese animals (tiger/panda) and experience some Chinese culture and traditions.

MATHS

We will focus on numbers beyond 10, and understanding the composition of these numbers. We will also develop our knowledge of doubles and the concept of 'equal.' In week 5, we will learn about measurement such as 'full, empty, half full' through practical exploration and hands-on experimentation.

LITERACY

We will be reading 'Whatever Next!' by Gill Murphy. We will act the story out and then innovate it to showcase our new knowledge about London landmarks. We look forward to sharing our narratives once complete.

In week 4, we will begin reading 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. A penguin gets lost from Twycross Zoo and needs our help, just like the book. We follow some instructions to return the penguin and then use our knowledge of instructions genre texts to write a set of instructions for Nursery when they visit the zoo next year. We will spend time reading these to the Nursery children to get them excited about moving up to Reception!
